In April 2013 the Government announced extra funding for schools in order to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision in primary schools. Below is an annual statement of our allocation and what we spent it on.



SPORTS FUNDING – 2016-17

Total £8,420

Training

£500

Training of children to become sports leaders: An outside agency was chosen, to give the training importance and fresh ideas. This gave new sports leaders the confidence to run sporting activities at lunch time. Enabling all pupils to learn to play games and enjoy active play from a variety of different sports.

Equipment

£5,000 (including £3526 held over from last year)

The buying of new equipment, both where old has become unsafe, such as netball posts, and new equipment such as cup and ball games to be used by play leader. This has enhanced and continues to improve playtimes and the improvement of curriculum delivery. This also includes other costs such as installation, so netball posts now fit into the tarmac of the playground and do not have a base to trip over, or run into. We have also used this money to Improve the outside area where wooden play equipment has become rotten and unsafe. Also having sports day lines and football pitch lines drawn up on the recreation area to support our delivery of these activities.

Organisation of matches and sporting activities

£2,500

We have continued to contribute to the organisation of and our participation in local inter- schools events held at Heathfield Community College such as multi skills, netball, football and tag rugby. This has continued to enable us to stretch the children's access to matches against a range of others and improve their team work, determination, sports skills and access to other higher level matches when successful.

With these developments we have been successful in earning sports mark Gold award this year for our continued progression and development of P.E. both in the curriculum and outside the school.

We have been able to participate in local sporting tournaments which have given our more able pupils the opportunities to take part in competitive sport, which they would not usually have. It has also increased the range of tournament opportunities that we have been able to take part in. We have been able to provide a greater range of after school clubs and this has benefited all pupils.

We have purchased some new PE equipment and playground equipment; this has promoted more purposeful play at break and lunchtimes. We are also providing older children with the chance of becoming play leaders, so giving them responsibility and skills to support this more purposeful play. We gained the Sainsbury's Sports Games award at Silver level; we gained Bronze last year.
