Snow procedure

If we have very bad weather and need to close the school this winter, this is the procedure: If the snow or ice comes over night, a decision will be made close to 7am as to whether it is safe to open the school. If the decision is taken not to open then a notice will be placed on our website, ESCC website, radio Sussex and a parent mail sent. You can also sign up for an 'alert' from ESCC to get a message if our school is closed. The ESCC website is updated around every 5 minutes. If we need to close during the day, we will Parentmail for parents to come and collect their children as quickly as possible.

Crossing Patrol

The ESCC lady that looks after the crossing patrol has asked me to highlight to the parents that they should use the crossing patrol. she said that there are parents that will walk to the end of the barrier and then cross without the patrol stopping the traffic putting themselves and their child at risk.
