# Tudors



**English:** We will be learning how to write persuasively and develop our skills as fantasy writers whilst continuing our focus on handwriting, spelling, punctuation and grammar. Through poetry we will develop our oral skills using traditional and performance poetry.

### Science:

As Scientists, will use our knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating. We will carry out an investigation comparing and recording our findings.

**PE:** We will develop our hockey skills and learn and create a dance sequence.

**Computing.** We will learn about appropriate online behaviour and understand a range of strategies to protect themselves and others from potential online dangers, inappropriate behaviour and bullying. Carry out research, create our own presentations and look at data.

### History:

As historians, we will travel back in time to the 1500s and meet the terrifying Tudors, a domineering dynasty that changed our history. Discover an opulent court where dancing and singing goes hand in hand with swift falls from favour, and even swifter falling of heads and learn what type of man Henry the 8<sup>th</sup> was.

### PSHE including RSE:
