

Term 2 Elm Class Year 6

Maths

We will continue to develop: our speed of recall of times table facts and our understanding of the four operations: short and long division, including remainders; find common factors and multiples; develop our knowledge of prime, square and cubed numbers; use BIDMAS to help solve calculations and will develop our understanding of fractions.



English

We will continue to learn and develop our understanding of phonics to apply spelling rules, grammar, and develop our handwriting style.

We will be using our writing skills to compose a letter in character, considering life in WW1. We will be reading 'The Birds of Flanders Fields', learn poetry by heart and will continue to use the book 'Rose Blanche' to develop our skills in recount/interview and narrative writing and extend our vocabulary and understanding of a text.

Science

We will be learning: to associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit; compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches and use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.

Computing

We will continue to develop our understanding regarding online safety, search technologies and presentations.

French

We will develop our accuracy in pronunciation and intonation, listen more attentively, and understand more complex phrases and sentences.

History and Geography

Through our topic we will learn that significant people, events, discoveries or inventions can affect many people over time and will use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.

Music

Develop a sense of pulse/beat and rhythm, develop our listening skills, explore music from different genres and develop an understanding of musical notation.

RE

We will learn why Advent is a special time for Christians; identify the different ways in which Christians celebrate Advent and be able to express our own beliefs and ideas.

Art and D&T

We will be looking at art by the WW1 artist Paul Nash and create our own art in his style and use colour wash and silhouettes to create imagery. We will use textiles to create a poppy and 'make do and mend' Christmas creations.
