We will develop our understanding of place value in numbers up to ten million, the four operations: addition and subtraction with whole numbers with more than four digits, inverse operation and solving multistep problems; multiplying four digit numbers by a one-digit and two and three-digit numbers; short and long division, including remainders and will be looking at factors.


Term 1 Elm Class Year 6

English

We will continue to learn and develop our understanding of phonics to apply spelling rules, grammar, and develop our handwriting style. We will be reading and using the book 'Letters of the Light House' and then 'Rose Blanche' to develop our skills in recount/interview and narrative writing and extend our vocabulary and understanding of a text.

Science

We will be learning to: identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, explain the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood; describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans; recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function and be able to present findings from enquiries, including using a line graph.

We will develop our accuracy in pronunciation and intonation, listen more attentively, and understand more complex phrases and sentences.

History and Geography
