English: We will be researching and learning how to write a narrative poem based on evolution and develop our knowledge of narrative writing, using excerpts from a film as inspiration. We will be continuing to extend our understanding of sentence structure and grammar and applying learnt spelling rules. We will enjoy developing our understanding and love of reading through our class text 'Rise up' by Amanda Li.



Maths: We will learn to convert fractions to percentages, order and compare fractions, decimals and percentages and find a percentage of an amount. We will learn how to convert metric units of measurement and solve calculations using metric units of measurement. We will continue to develop our speed of recall of times table facts and increase our speed when answering arithmetic questions.




Geography: We will be developing our mapping skills by plotting Darwin's journey and learn how the Galapagos Islands developed such rich biodiversity.



PSHE: We will be developing our understanding of whom we can turn to if we need help and develop empathy for others feelings and how these may be expressed.

RE: We will be learning about Pentecost and creation stories.




History: We will learn about Charles Darwin and his theory of evolution and learn about Mary Anning, a British fossil collector and palaeontologist.



Science: We will be learning about evolution: how living things create offspring of the same kind, but not normally identical to their parents; recognise that living things have changed over time, adapting to suit their environment and that fossils provide information about living things from millions of years ago.



Computing: We will continue to learn how we can keep ourselves safe when using technology and learn how to create a list of coding instructions, understand coding loops and debug coding instructions.



Music: We will further develop our knowledge of using our voices to sing, focusing on pitch, rhythm and duration.



PE: We will develop our net and ball skills through netball and learn traditional dances.

Art: We will develop our observational skills by looking carefully at shape, form, pattern and colour in nature. We will use coloured and black pens and create a print of our observation drawing.

French: We will learn vocabulary linked to months, seasons and weather and learn some phrases linked to these.
