Dear Parents and Carers,

Another fantastic couple of weeks in school. Thank you to all of the parents / carers who were able to join our Stay and learn phonics / reading sessions over the last few weeks. Last week we shared our school uniform policy. The purpose of this policy is to underline the idea that the child is coming to school wearing special clothes ready for work. It is a form of self-discipline, not a fashion statement. The uniform also helps develop the idea of belonging to a community. Please take time to read this. We ask again that all clothes are clearly named (and frequently checked) due to a number of items not showing easily visible names. Children must now bring a coat/ waterproof jacket for school every day.





We are still receiving a very high percentage of absence request forms. Children must be present and on time for school for 190 days a year; unless they are too ill to attend school or through an exceptional circumstane. Please book your family holidays and days out during our school holidays and on INSET days (175 days). Everytime your child misses school they are missing out on vital building blocks in their learning. I shared the attendance policy earlier this week via StudyBugs – please take time to read this.

#### Elm class:

Elm Class have had a busy start to the year: we enjoyed meeting Jayne Torville and researching questions we could ask her – she even let us hold her gold medal! Outdoor

learning has been enjoyed by Year 5 and 6 this term – potatoes were discovered, 'bake off' has been had in the mud kitchen and using natural objects to print a picture – to name just a few of the things we have done.

We are learning about the Anglo-Saxons and finding out why, where and when they invaded Britain; we have researched Andy Warhol and are creating our own art work on paper, printing and using technology and enjoying learning how to code different things in Minecraft.
