Dear Parents and Carers,

As we reach our half way point of this school year, there is so much to reflect on and celebrate. The children continue to thrive in school and are showing great commitment to their learning and happiness in school. There have been many opportunities that have enriched our curriculum and we continue to be excited about the remaining 3 terms.

Parent/ Carer sessions:

Thank you to all who have been able to join us for parent/ carer sessions this term. We continue to actively involve you in your child's education, to help all of our children make the best progress they can. In addition, our parent/ carer consultations have been hugely beneficial. All teachers will have shared the message of little and often reinforcement of learning at home and how much this can help your child. If you need any support in doing this, please contact your child's class teacher.

School House Day:

The children had a wonderful day working in our school house teams. There were a variety of activities that were rotated round throughout the day, focusing on speaking, listening, communication skills and both individual and team skills in the activities. The activities were reading with a partner, board games and puzzles, craft activities including colouring, collage and painting, games encouraging team support and learning outdoors learning about our outside environment and natural and man-made activities. The children and staff shared great feedback from our day and are keen to see this as a feature within our school year.

Safer Internet Day:

The children all enjoyed extending their knowledge of how to remain safe on the internet this week. All of the classes shared their learning in today's celebration assembly. Swimming:

Year 4 have just completed their swimming term, all having made great progress in their weekly sessions. The children have shared how much they have enjoyed the sessions and how they feel much more confident in the water, talking about going under water and being better using the main swimming strokes. The opportunity of developing early life saving techniques was fully embraced with a good understanding how different it feels to be in the water in clothes instead of swim wear.





Outdoor Learning:



Year 2, Year 3 and Year 6 have enjoyed outdoor learning this term, recognising the seasons, using natural objects to show the 4 seasons. The children have had fun learning new games, Eagle Eye being their favourite, learning campfire songs and learning about and exploring the equipment needed whilst out camping, especially The Bothy Bag.





The children have had fun bug hunting, playing in the mud kitchen (making Miss Sherwood 'judge' their cooking skills!) on 'The Great Sherwood Bake Off' and being out in the sun.
