Dear Parents and Carers,

As we complete our third week, routines have formed and the children continue to all show how sensible and resilient they are to change.

Teachers have now shared Meet the Teacher slides and learning web focuses for the term ahead. We hope these are useful documents. Further documents have been added to Google classroom which you might find helpful to support from home. We ask that all children read at least 3 times a week, and that you comment in their reading records to help us monitor this process. There are also logins in the reading record for Ed Shed and Google classroom.

Morning snacks have been a hot topic on our return to school. It is very difficult to create definitive lists due to hidden ingredients and salt and sugar content. As you know the children have a 15 minute break in the morning and may choose to have a snack, they may also bring a snack for after school provision. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free fruit or vegetable snack that is delivered to the school. There is always a variety to choose from. We are aware that some families have chosen to send in snacks for younger pupils, and those in year 3 to year 6 will need to bring in their own. Please choose these snacks carefully. The children should not have sweets, chocolate or crisps as a morning snack. If they are choosing a brunch bar this should not be chocolate coated or sprinkled either. Suggested snacks are; fruit, vegetables, crackers, popcorn (not toffee), cereal/ brunch bar, savory sandwich, rice cakes, bread stick, cheese. This list is not exhaustive but we hope it gives you a flavour! I must also remind families we are a nut free school due to allergies on the school site (therefore peanut butter etc should not be used).

Attendance is really important to your child's success and happiness at school. We all unfortunately become ill at times and sometimes this means we should remain at home. We ask you to think carefully about your child's reason for absence and ask you to support the school and nursery through regular attendance. Staff are always available in the mornings to discuss any concerns you have and will always phone if we then feel your child is unable to remain in school for the day.
