Dear Parents and Carers,

A warm welcome back to our final term of this academic year – as I feel I have said in each newsletter; where has the time gone?! We now have just 5 weeks and 2 days until the summer holiday; please refrain from taking any absence during these final weeks, as with any school day and week these school days are vital for your child's success in school and readiness for transition for the new school year. In September we have set the first of the allocated INSET days to the 3rd, 4th and 5th of September. This means the children will return to school on Monday 8th September. The final 2 INSET days will be set in September to align to the training required for staff in the new academic year.
